**Subject: Implementation of CCTNS Project in States/UTs**

Sir/ Madam,

This is in continuation to the MHA advisory of even number 22011/05/2010 – SR (CCTNS) CF No. 55700 dated 20<sup>th</sup> Jun 2017, requesting the CCTNS State/UT Nodal officers for completion of certain activities facilitating closure of the implementation phase of the project.

2. There have been requests from several States/UTs for extension of the tenure of the State Project Management Unit (SPMU) on the ground that the project has since been extended up to March 2018. In this regard, attention of all Nodal officers is invited to earlier recommendations of MHA, requesting for capacity building in the area of managing the implementation of the project. MHA has been constantly advising the States/UTs to put in place an in-built setup/mechanism to carry forward the activities hitherto being performed by the SPMUs in view of the fact that after completion of project implementation, the Police department of the States/UTs need to own and manage the CCTNS project. For that purpose, they need to arrange their own resources to make the project sustainable, as there may not be any financial support from MHA after March 2018.

3. It is therefore requested that the SPMU resources be trimmed down to one resource to look after the ongoing implementation activities, for capacity building, handholding and smooth transition. It is made clear that MHA will finance engagement of only one SPMU resource during the FY 2017-18 and there will be no financial support for engagement of SPMU resources after 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018, when the project is scheduled to be completed.

4. It is also requested that the States/UTs may evolve a system of incentivizing the Police personnel, responsible for their contribution towards successful implementation of the project and who could be entrusted with the responsibilities of SPMU activities. A committee consisting of the Nodal officers of some States is in the process of finalizing an incentive mechanism, which will be circulated to be considered and suitably adopted by the States/UTs. Till such time, the States/UTs are advised to reduce the SPMU resources to one resource only as mentioned above.
