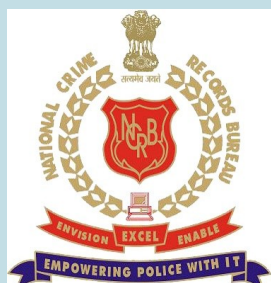

It gives me immense pleasure in putting October-December 2014 issue of NCRB Newsletter before our readers. I extend my warm New Year greetings to all readers, members of NCRB and their family members.

To achieve the pre-defined goal in implementation of CCTNS across the country, emphasis was given to address the concerns in respect of CAS-CCTNS application. Accordingly, meetings were arranged with CEO, Sr. Vice President and other Senior representatives of M/s WIPRO Ltd. over a range of issues like Certification of CAS, Performance testing, Real time solution etc.

Meetings to review the progress of implementation of CCTNS in the State of Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Haryana, Karnataka and West Bengal with System Integrators were held. I have visited the States of Assam, Bihar, Karnataka and Maharashtra to review the CCTNS progress, and realized that CCTNS teams are working hard to achieve the goal. Considering the future requirement, integration of UIDAI and Passport Seva Applications with CCTNS was also discussed with respective stake holders.

Connectivity issue, being vital activity in CCTNS, was taken up with BSNL to address the issues from States/UTs on priority basis.

Courses on CCTNS for Addl. SP/SP rank officers were conducted at NCRB, to make them aware about CCTNS and their role in CCTNS. Courses on the subjects like Network & e-Security, 1<sup>st</sup> Two Weeks Course on Fingerprint Science for Graduate Constables, were also conducted, to make the Investigating Officers aware about progress in I.T. and Finger Print Science. Apart from the above, 6 week courses for Foreign Police Officers on “Advanced Programme in I.T. in Law Enforcement” and “Advanced Finger Print Science”, were concluded with excellent feedbacks. The untiring efforts of team led by Shri D.M. Mitra, Joint Director(CCTNS) and Shri Surendra Panwar, Joint Director(A&T) are appreciable as the team has shown professional skills and zeal to attain the goals, under their monitoring.

## Training Programmes

6 week courses on “Advanced Programme in I.T. in Law Enforcement” and “Advanced Finger Print Science” for Foreign Police Officers were conducted from 13th October to 21st November 2014. 55 participants from 21 countries attended these training programmes. Apart from Agra, Jaipur and Delhi sight seeing, trainees were taken to Rashtrapati Bhawan and Parliament House.



Besides courses on CCTNS, Colour Portrait Building System, Network & e- Security for SI to Dy.SP rank officer and 1st Two Weeks course on Finger Print Science for Graduate Constables, Two workshops on CCTNS for SP and Addl. SP rank officers were also conducted wherein emphasis was given on overview of NeGP/MMPs, CCTNS architecture, role of various stakeholders in CCTNS and its implementation.

## DCT Branch

- ◆ The website of this Bureau plays the central role in information sharing with regard to Crime and Criminal Tracking Network & Systems – CCTNS. It enables the States to access information timely and at their comfortable time. Continuous efforts are made to keep the NCRB website updated and relevant with regards to the information related to CCTNS, CCIS, and Motor Vehicle Co-ordination System – MVCS.
- ◆ The Nodal Officer's Section of the CCTNS page has been updated with the latest version of CCTNS Patch Management Utilities. Timely upload of the CCTNS Progress Dashboard, CCTNS Newsletter, AIBE-Fingerprint Experts Results with Marksheet-2014, to enable the branches/officers concerned. New data entry module for Crime in India-CII and Accidental Deaths and Suicides in India – ADSI were uploaded. List of Missing persons and Un-Identified Dead Bodies are updated on weekly basis for larger publicity.
- ◆ The Bureau's website has registered more than 1,63,421 hits between Oct'14-Dec'14 totaling 15,35,980 hits since 12.08.2009 and the Hindi page of this Bureau with separate hit counter has registered more than 6,926 hits between Oct'14-Dec'14 totaling 48,818 since 31.05.2012 which is a sure indicator of its increasing popularity.
- ◆ During this period Video Conferencing with regards to CCTNS was successfully conducted with different States i.e. Sikkim (Gangtok NIC), Andhra Pradesh + Telangana (Hyderabad NIC), MP (Bhopal NIC).

Out of the 16 candidates who appeared for the examination, Shri. Rajesh Kumar. R., Finger Print Searcher, SD FPB, Palakkad, Kerala, Smt. Pratibha. P., Finger Print Searcher, SD FPB, Alappuzha, Kerala, and Smt. Leena Kumari Devi, Sub Inspector SFPB, CID, Assam, secured the first, second and third positions respectively.

### ◆ 12<sup>th</sup> Six Month Proficiency Course in Finger Print Science-

The 12th Six Month Proficiency Course in Finger Print Science was held at Kolkata Unit of Central Finger Print Bureau (CFPB) / NCRB from 01.07.2014 to 31.12.2014. The training course was attended by 19 - officials of the rank of Sub-Inspectors or equivalent. The final examination including practical was also conducted to assess the trainees knowledge & skills in respect of Finger Print Science. All the 19 participants successfully completed the course. Sub Inspector Manohar Ram Lohia, of Uttarakhand Police secured 1<sup>st</sup> position, and was awarded with "Best Trainee Memento" by the Incharge, Central Finger Print Bureau, New Delhi.

## Statistical Branch

- ◆ Statistical Branch of NCRB has developed a new software package for data collection, consolidation and report publication for revised proforma of 'Crime in India' and 'Accidental Deaths & Suicides in India'. Newly developed software is also made available on our website <http://ncrb.gov.in> under publication link.
- ◆ A total of 227 datasets in open format, from the annual reports of the Bureau, have been uploaded on national data portal <http://data.gov.in>.

## Crime Records Branch

The Crime Records branch has been dealing with tracing of Missing persons through manual efforts and as a result many cases have been solved. A new web enabled software for tracing of Missing Persons is being developed by this Bureau which would mean creation of a database containing data of all States/UTs. Apart from Police, the access will be given to general public to achieve optimal results.

### अपहृत युवक के शव की शिनाख्त

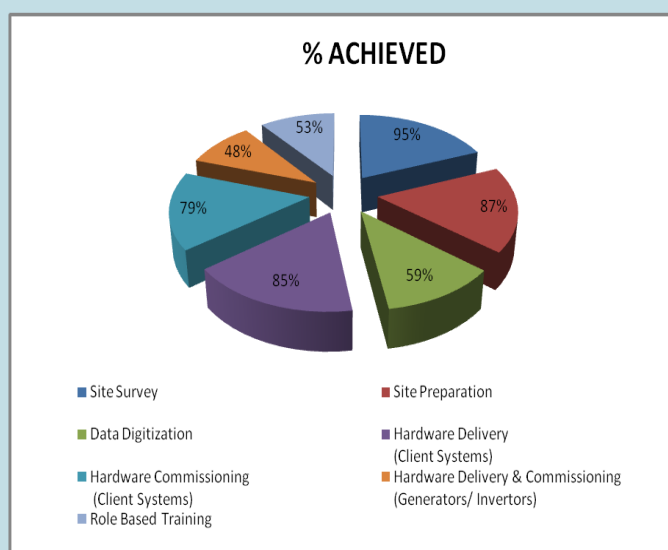
दिनांक 04.12.2014 को एक 22, वर्षीय युवक मनोज पुत्र श्री मोहन लाल की गुमशुदगी की सूचना थाना मंगोलपुरी में दर्ज की गई थी। उसी दौरान एक 25 वर्षीय अज्ञात युवक के मृत पाये जाने की सूचना थाना नरेला में दर्ज की गई। जब मनोज के अपहरण की रिपोर्ट इस कार्यालय को प्राप्त हुई तो डीलिंग हैंड सब इंस्पेक्टर श्री अशोक शर्मा ने पूरी रिपोर्ट ध्यान से पढ़ी और उस समय तक जितना भी रिकार्ड लावारिश शव पाये जाने का कार्यालय में उपलब्ध था, छान मारा परंतु अगवा मनोज के हलिये व पहनावे से मिलता कोई रिकार्ड न मिला।

यह सोच कर कि हो सकता है किसी थाने में कोई लावारिश शव या बेहोश व्यक्ति मिला हो और ZIPNET SITE पर सूचना को UPLOAD किया हो, अतः ZIPNET SITE को चैक करना शुरू किया। आखिर मेहनत रंग लाई व थाना नरेला क्षेत्र में एक व्यक्ति की हत्या करके फेंके जाने की रिपोर्ट FIR No. 1566 दिनांक 05.12.14 में दर्ज थी। अज्ञात मृतक का चेहरा व कपड़े बहुत हद तक अगवा मनोज से मिल रहे थे। मनोज के पिता को राजस्थान फोन करके NCRB दिल्ली बुलाया गया। दिनांक 12.1.15 को ZIPNET पर उपरोक्त FIR 1566 अनुसार अज्ञात युवक के शव के फोटो द्वारा अपने अगवा पुत्र मनोज के रूप में पहचान लिया। NCRB ने दिल्ली पुलिस को इस केस के अन्वेषण में महत्वपूर्ण योगदान दिया।
